This event was hosted in the community of Lloydminster but brought together business leaders from indigenous communities all-over north-eastern Alberta and north western Saskatchewan. The reported business activity coming out of the event exceeded the 3-million-dollar mark (as reported through follow-up surveys after the event) (this number could in fact be larger and just not reported). This event showcases indigenous owned businesses, both privately and community owned and operated. The Summit encourages non-indigenous companies to explore what opportunities might be available through collaboration. Numerous organizations partner to host this event and we are exceptionally happy to have been part of the successes. ## **All Partners Workshop**
